Rental Agreement:

In consideration of the covenants herein contained, the Operator with this document hereby leases to the undersigned "Renter", upon the terms, covenants, and conditions, herein set out, the aircraft designated on the flight schedule, hereinafter referred to as "aircraft".

- I. Renter acknowledges and agrees: that the aircraft is the property of the Operator; that he has inspected the aircraft and has found it in good mechanical condition.
- II. Renter will return the aircraft at agreed time, weather permitting. If delayed, Renter will notify Operator as soon as possible.
- III. The aircraft will be properly secured when not in use.
- IV. Renter expressly acknowledges personal liability to pay Operator on demand the following:
 - a. Service and time charges computed at the applicable rate until said aircraft is returned to location specified by Operator.
 - b. Any loss or damage to the airplane, or its parts or equipment during the rental period. Deductibles (\$500 not in motion; \$1000 in motion) are the responsibility of the Renter.
 - c. The amount of any parking tiedown, or hangar charges, or any other charges until the aircraft is returned or Operator.
- V. Renter agrees to report all accidents, major and/or minor, to the Operator and NTSB as soon as practicable after the accident and:
 - a. Do what is necessary to prevent further damage to the aircraft.
 - b. Not tamper with, molest or attempt to repair any part of the airplane, or its accessories, but will telephone Operator collect for instructions.
 - c. Not hold Placerville Aviation or the aircraft owner liable for damage to persons or property related to Renters operation of the aircraft.

- VI. If the airplane is abandoned away from the home base airport, Renter will be charged pilot's expenses plus flight time at dual rates to return the aircraft to home base.
- VII. Renter agrees that said aircraft shall not be used or operated:
 - a. For any illegal purpose;
 - b. In any race, speed test or contest;
 - c. By any person other that renter who signed the agreement;
 - d. Outside the limits of the continental United States;
 - e. To carry passengers or property for a consideration.
- VIII. Renter agrees that in the event suit is instituted by the Operator to recover possession or to enforce any to the terms, covenants, and condition hereof, or to collect any sum or sums of money, damages or costs, the Renter agrees to pay all costs and reasonable attorney's fee incurred by the Operator in such suit or suits.
- IX. Renter by affixing his signature hereon does agree to follow Flight Safety Rules.
- X. Aircraft may be reserved for any reasonable duration (as determined by the Operator), including daylong and overnight. Renter agrees to pay a minimum rental rate of two hours per day for reservations occurring between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm on weekdays, and three hours per day for weekends and holidays.
- XI. Renter agrees to pay a cancellation fee equal to one hour of aircraft rental if Renter cancels within 24 hours of scheduled reservation time or is a no-show. Cancellation fee will be waived if cancellation is due to weather.

FLIGHT SAFETY RULES:

- 1. Pilot Certificate Renter must hold a valid and current pilot certificate with appropriate rating. The renter named on the rental contract shall be the pilot in command and will be responsible for the aircraft at all times.
- 2. Currency Renter must possess evidence of a current biennial review and medical certificate.
- 3. Preflight Renter will personally conduct a preflight inspection of the aircraft as prescribed by the manufacturer. Renter shall use the manufacturer's recommended pre-takeoff, cruise, and pre-landing checklist.
- 4. Weather Renter shall plan to operate the aircraft only in weather conditions appropriate to his rating and the aircraft's equipment status.
- 5. All State, Federal, and Local Regulations Renter will comply with all applicable regulations.
- 6. Takeoff and Landing Area No takeoff or landings shall be made on any area other than the runways of an airport, designed, constructed, maintained, and customarily used as an airport, and has a hard surface runway.
- 7. Physical Condition Renter shall not operate the aircraft after he has used intoxicating liquor, tranquilizers, or sleep inducing drugs within the last 12 hours.
